SCHEDULE

8:00-9:00AM	Late Vendor sign up on Spinnaker at entrance to event – you will have to pay \$20 to get into the marina.
7:30AM-9:30AM	Vehicles allowed to travel on path to offload
8:00AM	Coffee & Bagels available from Nissa Food Truck on site
9:30AM	All vehicles must be out of event area (unless they have been approved prior to the event)
9:30AM-10:00AM	Park in lot and use a hand truck to set up
10:00AM	Open for business
6PM Sat./5PM Sun.	Booths shut down (no earlier).
6:15PM Sat./5:15 Sun.	OK to bring in vehicle to load up – follow the yellow arrows on the map to enter the same one-way you came in in the morning.

NEED TO STAY IN A HOTEL? The Doubletree-Hilton is right in the thick of the event.

GETTING THERE: Take the University Avenue exit off I-80 in Berkeley and head toward the Bay. Pay \$20 vehicle entrance fee. At the 2nd stop sign when the road divides, bear right. Vendor entrance is on your right about 100' after you curve left onto Spinnaker Way. Driving on event path is all ONE WAY. See the map and follow the yellow arrows for the in and out routes.

SIGN UP DAY OF EVENT: 8:00–9:00AM. Pull up just past the vendor entrance and you will find Lisa who will register you. You may purchase more than one space. **DO NOT OFF LOAD OR TRY TO SET UP BEFORE YOU PAY FOR YOUR SPACE.** After you register, you go park in the meadow lot that you drove past on the way in. **No vehicles at your booth during event.**

SET UP: 8:00AM to 9:30AM. Booths are open 10AM–6PM Sat./5PM Sun. Your locations will be marked at the site on the grass. Booths are on dry grass that is not particularly even (some gopher holes!). Please set up behind the white line. We DO NOT provide any tables, chairs, electrical cords, or booths. OK to bring a rug or flooring.

BOOTH SIZE: 10' x 10'. There is a lot of wind so bring weights or tie downs for your canopy. Sides are recommended for wind protection. No sharing of spaces.

BREAK DOWN: Stay open until 6PM Sat./5PM Sun. You may move your vehicle onto the ONE WAY path 15 minutes after event is over and after pedestrians have cleared the event. Do not block the path while loading up.

SECURITY: Overnight security is stationed at the event HQ RV so you may leave your booth up. However, we do not accept liability for materials or equipment left out overnight. Best to lower your canopy half way over your tables.

ATMs: We will have three ATM machines on site.

GREENING OF THE EVENT: Trying to be good citizens of the planet, we are a green event! We have hired Green Mary (707–548–7582) to help us. No sales of alcohol. No Styrofoam is allowed in Berkeley. Remove all plastic wrappers from products before you come to the marina. Recycle your cardboard by giving it to one of Mary's crew. The Marina is an ecologically sensitive area so please be respectful. Pack it in, pack it out.

ELECTRICITY: There is no electricity available for you in Cesar Chavez Park unless pre-arranged. Quiet generators like the Honda EU 3000 are OK. If it is too loud, you will be asked to muffle it or turn it off. No music in booths because there is event music for the kite demos.

WATER: Water is available from a low spigot at the drinking fountain near the HQ/First Aid booth. BYO containers. Do not attach a hose and leave it there. **DO NOT WASH ANYTHING HERE** – it drains directly onto the land. Wastewater containers are near the port-o-lets on the north and south side of the event. Please do not throw wastewater onto the ground – it drains into our cherished Bay.

RESTRICTED:

Alcohol-free event. No sales of alcohol. No drinking alcohol in booths!

No Smoking or Vaping of any kind in festival area.

No Styrofoam is allowed in Berkeley.

No fireworks, snap pops, silly string or kite sales (unless you are Tom McAllister!).

No food, candy, or water sales or give-a-ways unless you are a food vendor.

No clipboard activity outside of your booth.

Remove all plastic packaging before coming to the event. Plastic is OK for food packaging.

No sharing of booths.

EVENT CANCELLATION: In case of extremely bad weather or other disasters the show may be canceled at the discretion of the producers. Call 510.548.5335 for recorded information that morning. No refunds or payments will be made if show is canceled.
